Inveno Health Inc.

Inveno Health Inc. opened for business June 2 at 431 Boonville Ave. The company, named after the Latin word for discovery, is a for-profit venture designed to market, distribute, manufacture and test products developed at nonprofit St. John's Medical Research Institute; both are part of the Jordan Valley Innovation Center's plan to stimulate growth and invention in Springfield. St. John's Technical Research Director Keela Davis is largely responsible for securing the \$574,000 grant used to start Inveno. Davis will aid Operations Manager Matt Price, the company's single full-time employee, in commercializing Inveno's five inaugural products, including an antiseptic eye drop called Povinol.
